



Students, faculty and staff who are vaccinated will have different quarantine guidelines. If a student or employee is fully vaccinated (two weeks past second dose), the quarantine time may be dropped to 5 days with a negative in certain situations. Vaccinated individuals may return to school after 5 days and a negative test even if there is a household positive. The following conditions must be met:

1. Proof of vaccination must be brought to the main office to keep on file.
2. Proof of a negative test from a medical professional must be provided to the school.
3. The individual must continue to wear a mask in all situations for 10 days.
4. The individual must not show any signs or symptoms. If symptoms develop, they must immediately be tested.

Guidelines for Attendance:

- Parents should screen children for temperature and symptoms at home. This will help mitigate the spread of COVID-19 to ensure our school can stay open.
- Students/staff who have a household contact with COVID-19 must stay home for 10 days. They may return to school with proof of a negative test.
- Students who have a close contact (within 6 feet, for 15 minutes, in 24 hours) with COVID-19 must stay home for 4 days. They may return to school with proof of a negative test
- If a student or staff member has been diagnosed with COVID-19, he or she must stay home for 10 days and be symptom/fever free without medication for 3 days (72 hours). They may re-enter school on the 11th day if these conditions are met. **They do not need a negative test.**
- Return to School: student or staff member must be symptom/fever free without medication for 72 hours. Anyone with a household contact or close contact may re-enter school on the 11th day if these conditions are met.

Covid Addendum Effective January 24, 2022

What to do if we have a household positive case?

Any student that has a household positive (sibling, parent, etc.) will be required to quarantine for 5 days. If the student is not showing symptoms, they may test on the fifth day and return on the sixth day with a negative test. This is a change from a 10-day quarantine in the previous policy. You should test your child for Covid as soon as they develop any symptoms. If they develop any symptoms after returning to school the student should be immediately tested. No mask will be required to return to school.

What to do if my child tests positive for Covid?

If you have a student who tests positive for Covid-19, they must quarantine at home. If after seven days, they are not showing any symptoms they may return to school. Your student will **be required** to wear a mask for the remaining three days. Failure to comply with this policy will result in the student being sent home for the remainder of a 10-day quarantine. Any siblings of a positive student must quarantine as well based on the guidelines for a household positive explained above.
